

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Wednesday 07 Nov 2007

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Northern and western parts will be cloudy with occasional light rain, chiefly in the northwest. Elsewhere should be dry with plenty of broken cloud, probably sunniest in the south and east. Generally breezy with moderate westerly winds, but windy in the north, and gales will develop over northern Scotland overnight.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Windy on Thursday. Severe gales are likely over northern, especially northeast, Scotland. Plenty of cloud and some rain will push south across most parts during the day, with largely fine but cold conditions following. Staying quite windy on Friday, with some fine spells and some outbreaks of rain spreading southeastwards.
