Headline:

Rain, strong winds northwest. Elsewhere mainly dry, southeast becoming warm.

Today:

Northern Ireland, northwest Scotland windy with outbreaks of rain largely dying out. Elsewhere largely dry with sunny spells, feeling warm.

Tonight:

Mostly dry with late sunshine, then clear spells overnight. Showery rain developing across western England, west Wales.

Outlook for Thursday:

Mostly dry, sunny spells at first. Showery rain, locally heavy and thundery, developing in north and west. Feeling very warm in sunshine.
