Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Mostly cloudy and misty this morning. Western parts will have rain,
locally heavy, and strong winds. These conditions will push east
during the day, with brighter, less windy weather in the west. Mild.
Mostly cloudy with spells of rain across the UK tonight, especially
heavy in the southwest, turning more showery later. Mostly mild.
Windy. Gales around exposed coasts.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Heavy, blustery showers and some more persistent spells of rain on
Friday. Windy, especially in the far south. Temperatures around
normal.

Rather cloudy and showery on Saturday with some heavy, squally
showers, especially over southwest England and Wales. Mild in places.
