

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A chilly start with patchy frost and fog. Becoming windy, with gales along the coasts, as cloud and rain spreads eastwards. Some rain will become heavy, especially across parts of Scotland and Northern Ireland this afternoon. The rain will continue overnight, but will start to clear Northern Ireland and the Hebrides from the early hours.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Rain will clear northeastwards on Friday with gales easing at the coasts but it will stay windy. Heavy showers will then follow across the UK from the southwest. Further rain will move across the south of the UK on Saturday with gales in places.
