

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be fairly cloudy with some scattered showers in Wales, southern England and Northern Ireland, but staying mainly warm and dry elsewhere with bright spells. Southeasterly winds will strengthen as the afternoon wears on, especially in the north. Overnight, spells of rain for Northern Ireland and western coasts of England and Wales, but staying mainly dry elsewhere.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Windy again with heavy rain spreading slowly eastwards to many areas during Monday, though staying dry and bright in Scotland and northeast England. The rain moves into northeast England and Scotland by Tuesday, leaving a brighter day elsewhere with sunshine and showers.
