

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be milder this morning, with frost less likely for most. A band of rain will clear the southeast, leaving most of the UK dry, bright and breezy. Some showers will develop through the day and overnight. These will be most frequent in the north and west with snow falling on the Scottish Mountains, .

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Wednesday and Thursday will be mainly dry and bright, but with some patchy cloud and rain affecting western and central areas. It will also be rather breezy, with gales likely along exposed coastlines in the west, north and east, but temperatures will stay rather mild.
