Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1200 UTC Monday 02 November to 1200 UTC Tuesday 03 November 2015

General Situation

High pressure centred over the Continent will bring settled conditions to the British Isles during the next 24 hours, although areas of fog over the land may drift offshore to affect some coastal waters at times.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 near Sutherland and Orkney.
Moderate or rough to west and north of Orkney, otherwise slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable mainly south 3 or 4, but southwest 5 or 6 near Cape Wrath.
Mainly slight, but moderate, occasionally rough to west and north of Orkney.
Occasional rain later.
Moderate or good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming variable 3 at times in south.

Slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Fog patches in south.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly, becoming variable, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, rain later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

South 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast, becoming variable at times, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, showers later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches, showers later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 at times.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.

Occasional rain at first, showers later.

Moderate or good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Fog patches at first, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 or 5, veering westerly 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Moderate or good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight or moderate in east, moderate in west, but becoming rough later near the Isles of Scilly.

Occasional rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4.

Rough at first near the Isles of Scilly, otherwise slight or moderate.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in far southwest.

Occasional rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in far southwest.

Occasional rain, showers later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south, becoming variable 2 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far south.

Occasional rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in far south.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Moderate or good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time in south, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, occasional rain later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Moderate or good.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, occasional rain later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Fog patches, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Moderate or good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Fog patches, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.

Moderate or rough.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 3 or less.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Occasional rain later.

Moderate or good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times in south.

Slight or moderate.

Drizzle at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Drizzle at times, mainly in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times in south.

Moderate or rough.

Drizzle at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Drizzle at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Monday 02 Nov 2015 at 1200 UTC until Tuesday 03 Nov 2015 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Ridge of high pressure will decline with various weak troughs moving over Shetland area from the west.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in northwest and 3 later in south.

Moderate or rough, becoming occasionally slight close to northeast Shetland.

Occasional rain later, risk fog patches later, mainly in southeast.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later, very poor in far southeast.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Tuesday 03 Nov until 1200 UTC on Tuesday 03 Nov:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first in south.
Moderate or rough, becoming occasionally slight close to northeast Shetland at first.

Occasional rain. Risk fog patches mainly at first in southeast.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor, very poor at first in southeast.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

East to southeast 3 to 4, locally 5, increasing 4 to 5 overnight.

Slight, locally moderate from later tonight.

Risk of mist or fog mist patches in the north early afternoon isolated showers developing before dawn.

Good, locally moderate, perhaps poor or very poor in the north at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast to south 4 to 5, perhaps locally 6 for a time Tuesday evening, locally variable 1 to 3 for a time early morning then southwesterly 4 to 5 in the morning.

Slight, locally moderate at times, with swell.

Isolated showers likely early afternoon and again from around midnight.

Good, occasionally moderate in showers.
