Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be a day of sunshine and showers for many areas. Showers are likely to be heavy and thundery in places, particularly central England and Wales and towards the Southwest, while parts of southeast England remain dry. Most places becoming dry and rather cold overnight, but staying breezy and cloudy in the northwest, with some rain arriving by dawn.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Outbreaks of rain and strengthening winds will spread across the northern half of the UK during Monday. Mostly dry further south but becoming generally cloudy. On Tuesday, most places unsettled, wet and windy, but largely dry still in the southeast.
