

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Friday 07 Mar 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain pushing southeastwards, increasingly light and patchy, clearing southeast England early afternoon. Then dry with sunny periods for central and southern areas, feeling warm in light winds. Colder in the north with some squally wintry showers northern Scotland. Tonight starts dry with lengthy clear spells for many, before clouding over, with rain spreading across Northern Ireland and Scotland.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rain across Northern Ireland and Scotland on Saturday tending to ease, though remaining cloudy and windy. England and Wales becoming brighter, with warm afternoon sunshine. Sunday, cloud and outbreaks of rain in the north spreading southeastwards, but warm sunshine in the southeast.
