

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Saturday 01 Mar 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A frosty start in places, with fog patches dispersing to leave most places dry with sunny spells and isolated heavy showers. Patchy rain will eventually clear the far southeast of England but heavier rain, and hill snow, is expected in Scotland and Northern Ireland later. This will continue eastwards overnight with most other parts staying largely dry with clear spells.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
There will be some dry and rather cloudy weather on Sunday morning but rain, hill snow and strong winds will spread across all areas by dusk. Sunshine and showers, some heavy, will follow on Monday, turning wintry on northern hills.
