Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
It will be a cold and mostly dry start, but very windy in the north. Rain, already across northwest Scotland, will spread slowly south and east, however parts of eastern England will remain dry. Wintry showers will follow in the northwest by dusk, and continue overnight. It will also stay very windy.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

It will remain very windy on Wednesday, with widespread gales, severe across many northern and some western areas, Through Thursday, it will remain very windy, although winds will gradually weaken through the day. There will be further frequent showers on Wednesday and Thursday, wintry across northern Britain.
