Headline:

Showery rain northwest. Elsewhere dry at first, risk showers later.

This Evening and Tonight:

Showers in northwest largely dying out. Dry, clear spells, at first elsewhere, showery rain developing across Wales, north and west England.

Thursday:

Rain, locally heavy and thundery, Scotland, Northern Ireland. Rain clearing most of Scotland later. Sunny spells, very warm, showers elsewhere, southwest more cloudy. East, south coasts misty.

Outlook for Friday:

Mostly cloudy, thundery rain. Showers, sunny spells, in west. Misty in east.
