

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 1945 on Wednesday 23 Jun 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Scattered cloud and sunny intervals for most places, with occasional showers. These will be most frequent in Scotland, while many southern parts remain dry. Rather cloudy with mist or fog patches in western areas at first, these becoming generally confined to coasts during the morning. Another warm day with gentle westerly winds.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Most places dry on Friday with lengthy sunny periods and a low chance of catching an isolated shower. Similar on Saturday, but with an increased risk of showers in Northern Ireland, northwest Scotland and, later, eastern England. Staying misty along some western and southern coasts, but generally warm.
