Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scattered showers are likely over some western and northwestern parts of the UK but for most a dry day with variable amounts of cloud and some warm sunny spells. Staying dry tonight with patchy mist, fog and low cloud reforming.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday, Scotland and Northern Ireland cloudy with rain at times and brisk southwesterly winds. England and Wales mainly dry, cloudy at times in the north and west, best sunshine in the south and east. On Friday, northern areas cloudy with rain at time, central and southern parts mainly dry with lighter winds and some sunshine but also overnight fog patches.
