

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 16 May 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Any remaining rain will soon clear the southeast to leave a dry and increasingly sunny day across the southern half of the U.K. Further north, it'll be windy with occasional showers, some heavy with thunder, and perhaps wintry over the Scottish hills. Overnight, showers across Scotland will merge to more persistent rain, whilst most other places remain dry.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Showery rain will affect northern areas during Sunday, heaviest across Scotland, whilst England and Wales remain largely dry and bright. Rain will become more persistent overnight, moving southeast on Monday and clearing away by early afternoon. Sunshine and blustery showers will follow.
