Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Wet and windy conditions across the northwest of Britain will steadily move southeastwards, reaching southeast England by late evening. Ahead of the rain in the southeast, it will be another fine and very warm day with sunny spells. The rain will continue to move slowly southeastwards overnight with clearer conditions following into the northwest along with some scattered showers.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

The rain will slowly clear eastwards during Saturday with sunshine and showers following. Some of the showers could be heavy in the north and west, especially on Sunday. Temperatures will be near normal, but it will feel noticeably fresher in southeast.
