Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
It will be a cloudy start to Monday across much of eastern Scotland and northeastern England, along with isolated showers. Elsewhere, apart from a few freezing fog patches, it will be a dry and frosty start with sunny spells, and as the day goes on this brighter weather will also spread to most northeastern areas. It will remain cold.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

On both days it will remain mostly dry and cold with variable amounts of cloud allowing some sunny spells to develop in many areas. Frosts will form overnight, along with some freezing fog patches, which will be locally slow to disperse.
