Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Heavy showers developing in southern England and Wales with some brightness.
Largely dry and bright in Scotland and northern England at first, then rain,
heavy at times is expected later. Northern Ireland and Western Scotland staying
largely dry and bright with isolated showers. Most areas becoming dry overnight.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Further heavy showers will break out across Wales, Northern Ireland and southern
England on Monday. Scotland and northern England will be generally drier. Most
areas will see some sunny spells. Continuing very wet through Tuesday with some
heavy rain at times, especially in eastern and central areas.
