Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain across northeast Scotland becoming increasingly confined to Shetland and Orkney through the morning, where also windy. Elsewhere a bright and breezy day, with a good deal of dry weather, but also some locally heavy showers, most likely in the west.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
A spell of wet, and perhaps very windy, weather is likely to spread northeastwards across parts of the UK on Sunday, bringing locally heavy rain. Any lingering rain on Monday, clearing northeastwards. Otherwise, a mixture of sunny spells and scattered showers is likely, these sometimes heavy. A windy day, and very windy in the north.
