

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 10 Apr 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
After any early mist clears it should be a dry and fine day with some prolonged warm sunshine, in western parts especially. Further east, cloud is expected to develop during the afternoon turning the sunshine hazy. Remaining dry overnight with patchy cloud for most places, but feeling chilly in rural spots. Winds should remain light.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Plenty of sunshine for Scotland and Northern Ireland, but patchy cloud elsewhere breaking later with some sunny intervals. Northeasterly winds will strengthen in southeastern England where it will feel colder. Staying mostly dry on Monday but becoming cloudier and feeling colder in fresh northeasterly winds.
