Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A breezy and chilly day, with many places becoming drier, brighter and sunnier.
However, a little snow will continue over parts of Scotland and Northern
Ireland, with scattered showers for western parts of the UK later. It will be a
cold and frosty night, with further outbreaks of rain, sleet and snow across
northern parts of the UK.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
It will stay chilly on Sunday, with further wintry showers expected for northern
England and Scotland, but it should be dry and sunny elsewhere. Rain and strong
winds will spread from the west during Monday, bringing milder temperatures to
southern Britain.
