Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
England and Wales, dry and mainly sunny with light winds after fog patches clear, though low cloud affecting extreme southeastern England at first and again overnight into Tuesday morning. Very warm inland, cooler near coasts where sea breezes develop. Northwestern Britain, cloudier with outbreaks of rain spreading northwards, sunny spells following.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

On Tuesday, many parts dry with good sunny periods and very warm or hot, though Northern Ireland and northwest Scotland cloudier with a few showers but still warm. Northwestern areas cloudy on Wednesday with some rain or showers. Elsewhere hot, locally very hot with sunny spells and thundery showers.
