Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cloud and rain will clear Scotland, then later in Northern Ireland, leaving brighter and drier conditions. Staying breezy and cloudy with further outbreaks of rain over Northeast England, whilst everywhere else will see brighter spells and scattered heavy showers. The showers ease overnight, becoming dry for many, however staying cloudy with further outbreaks of rain in eastern parts.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

England and Wales will be breezy and fairly cloudy on both days, with outbreaks of rain in southern and eastern England during Friday. However, further north in Scotland and Northern Ireland it will be drier with a good deal of sunshine.
