Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
It will be a fine and dry day with a good deal of sunshine across England and Wales and feeling very warm by the afternoon, especially towards the south and east. However, Northern Ireland and Scotland will be generally cooler and cloudier with occasional light rain, though brightening up in the north later.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Mainly dry with sunny spells across many parts of the UK on Monday and feeling warm. However, cloudier with light rain across Scotland. Becoming more widely cooler and breezy from the northwest on Tuesday with scattered showers, though remaining warm and fine in the far south.
