Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Eastern England, along with central and eastern Scotland will start misty before low cloud becomes confined to coastal areas. Otherwise, England and Wales can expect some sunshine with showers and thunderstorms in western regions edging a little further east.
In Scotland and Northern Ireland, showers will move from the south, turning heavy in places, perhaps with thunder, especially in western areas.
Many regions will become very warm today, particularly in the south. Tonight, many places will be very humid and misty with some showery rain and a risk of heavy downpours.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Unsettled with showery rain and some thunderstorms.
