Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Outbreaks of rain will spread southeastwards to most areas, bringing misty low cloud to western coasts and hills. Brighter weather will extend across Scotland, Northern Ireland and later to northern parts of England and Wales. Rather breezy, but feeling quite warm in sheltered southern areas.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Sunday will be cloudy with rain at times in the north, but bright and warm in the south. Very windy in the north, with severe gales in the northwest. Many areas dry on Monday, with southern and eastern areas seeing sunny spells. The north will see a few showers but it will become less windy.
