Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Rain over central and southern England during the morning will gradually clear, clearing southeast England during the afternoon. Elsewhere, some sunshine and scattered showers, the showers mainly in the north and west, and most prolonged and heavy near northwestern coasts and hills. It will start very windy with severe gales in the north, but winds gradually easing. Becoming cooler, temperatures just below normal.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

More very wet and very windy weather will sweep east on Tuesday, with storm force winds in Scotland. Wednesday sees a mixture of sunshine and blustery showers, wintry in the northwest. Mild again, but then cooler Wednesday.
