

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Thursday 07 Jul 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Showers and sunny intervals for most, with occasionally heavy showers giving a risk of thunder before easing by evening. Showers may become slow-moving in northwestern UK, with brisk winds elsewhere moving them through. Overnight, longer spells of occasionally heavy rain will affect far eastern UK, whilst a broad swathe of showers spreads northeastwards from southwestern areas, coupled with strong winds.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Sunny intervals will be separated by occasionally heavy and thundery showers, blown through on brisk winds. Central parts of the UK will be more generally cloudy with longer spells of rain on Friday, with some easing expected countrywide by Saturday.
