

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Friday 05 Jan 2018

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A band of persistent rain and hill snow over Scotland edges southwards. Sunny spells further south with showers, locally heavy, possibly thundery. Wintry showers across northern Scotland. Windy in the south at first, and in the north later. Cloud and patchy rain sinks further south overnight. Clearer elsewhere with some showers. Cold, especially in the north.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Windy for most on Saturday and colder for all. Cloud and patchy rain will become confined to the south. Sunny spells elsewhere with wintry showers for northeastern coasts. Sunday will be very cold, largely dry with severe overnight frost, and windy in the south.
