Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Monday: Showers will become more widespread across northeast England, some possibly heavy and thundery. Largely cloudy conditions with showers initially across northwestern Scotland will extend across most remaining parts of Scotland. Elsewhere largely dry with sunny spells, before scattered showers break out, a few heavy with a low risk of thunder. However, many areas of southern England and Wales will remain dry.
Feeling pleasant in light winds and near normal temperatures.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Tuesday and Wednesday: Sunny spells and scattered showers, some heavy and perhaps thundery. Wednesday evening rain is expected to move across southeast England and East Anglia. Temperatures near normal.
