Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Rain will become confined to southeastern parts of the UK today, with a welcomed drier interlude for much of the rest of the country, before further showers arrive in Northern Ireland this afternoon. It remains wet in the southeast for a time tonight, with a band of showers crossing other parts of the UK. Dry for many by morning though.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Sunshine and blustery showers for most as the rain finally clears the southeast on Saturday. More wet and windy weather arriving in Northern Ireland later, spreading across the whole country overnight. Very windy on Sunday with gales and squally showers.
