Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

Fog across parts of England and Wales will clear, then mainly dry with sunny spells. Rain already into Northwest Scotland will move southwards into Northern Ireland and Central Scotland later. The rain will extend into Central England and Wales overnight but will become light. Further south it will be dry with patchy fog reforming.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Light rain across parts of the north will die out on Friday with it brightening up. Further south patchy fog will clear to give a dry day with sunny spells. After the clearance of overnight fog, most parts will be dry on Saturday with some sunshine.
