#### General Situation

A shallow area of low pressure will move southeast into Northern Ireland on Thursday before filling on Friday. An area of high pressure will then build over Scotland with a complex low over France.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate north of Orkney.

Fair.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming west or southwest 3 or 4 for a time later.

Smooth or slight.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming northeast 3 to 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers in south.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then southwesterly 3 or 4 later in north.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

Variable 3 or less, becoming southeast 3 or 4 for a time, then becoming east or northeast 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in southwest.

Mainly fair.

Variable 3 or less, becoming east or northeast 4 to 6.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Thundery showers later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, backing northeast, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight at first in east, otherwise slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast 2 to 4, increasing 4 to 6 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time.

Showers developing.

Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming east or northeast 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate in west.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
East or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 4 to 6.  
Slight or moderate in west, smooth or slight in east.  
Showers developing.  
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or less, becoming east or northeast 3 to 5 later.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate near St Davids Head.  
Showers developing.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
East or northeast 3 to 5, occasionally 6 later.  
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Moderate or good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or less, becoming east or southeast 3 to 5.  
Smooth or slight.  
Rain for a time, otherwise showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
East or southeast, backing east or northeast, 3 to 5.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers at first.  
Moderate or good.

Isle of Man  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeasterly 2 or 3, backing easterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in east.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers later.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Easterly 4 or 5, backing northeasterly 3 or 4, veering easterly 4 or 5 later.  
Slight, occasionally moderate later.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southeast 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4, then east or northeast 3 to 5 later.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
East or northeast 3 to 5.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in far southeast.  
Showers at first.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 2 to 4, occasionally southeasterly 5 in the North Channel, becoming easterly or northeasterly 3 to 5 later.

Smooth or slight.  
Showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Easterly or northeasterly 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 for a time and again later.

Smooth or slight.  
Showers at first in south.  
Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:  
Variable 2 to 4, becoming easterly 4 or 5 later in far south.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Easterly 4 or 5 at first in far south, otherwise variable 2 to 4.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fair.  
Good.

24 hour forecast:  
Variable 2 to 4, becoming northeast 3 to 5 for a time.  
Smooth or slight.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 2 to 4, occasionally 5 in the far east of the area this afternoon and in the far south of the area this evening.

Smooth or slight.

Isolated showers mainly in the south of the area.

Good or very good, perhaps locally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 2 to 4, locally variable or northerly 1 to 3 in the south of the area in the morning, locally 5 in the north of the area in the afternoon, generally increasing 4 to 5 overnight, perhaps locally 6 mid-channel.

Smooth to slight, increasing slight to moderate overnight, perhaps rather rough mid-channel later.

Isolated showers mainly in the south, becoming more widespread and locally heavy in the evening and overnight, likely clearing by mid-morning Saturday.

Good, locally moderate or perhaps poor at times.

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
