Headline:

Outbreaks of rain/sleet/snow, persistent at times, especially over E/SE.England.

Today:

Sunny spells and wintry showers widely, locally heavy, especially to the east. SE.England will be cloudy and breezy, with prolonged rain/sleet/snow. Cold.

Tonight:

Sleet/snow and strong winds continuing in SE.England. Wintry showers in north and east bringing some accumulations. Clear and frosty elsewhere. Widespread ice expected.

Outlook for Thursday:

Sleet/snow and strong winds lingering in SE.England. Rain in north later. Otherwise cold and dry.
