Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A band of cloud and outbreaks of patchy rain over central parts will become confined to southern parts of the UK today. Elsewhere, there will be a mixture of sunny spells and wintry showers, especially for northeastern coasts. A strong northeasterly wind will make it feel bitterly cold. A widespread frost tonight with increasingly clear skies.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Dry, sunny and cold on Sunday, with strong winds in the south making it feel bitterly cold. After a frosty start on Monday, it will turn cloudier from the south, with some patchy drizzle at times. Best of the sunshine in northwest Scotland.
