

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Monday 10 Nov 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Any fog patches dispersing this morning, quite slowly across northeastern parts.  
A few showers near coasts, locally heavy and thundery in southeast England at first. Rain, locally heavy, and stronger winds spreading into southwestern parts and Northern Ireland by evening and then continuing northeastwards overnight. Coastal gales likely. However the far north and east probably remaining dry.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Conditions remaining unsettled and often windy across the UK on Tuesday and Wednesday, especially across western areas, with showers or longer spells of rain, which are likely to be locally heavy at times. Temperatures around average and generally frost free.
