Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A cold day with some sleet and snow for Wales, and southwest and central parts of England. Some heavy snow showers following for western and northwestern parts of the UK. Drier in the southeast, although isolated wintry showers possible later. Mostly cold and clear overnight with a severe frost by dawn.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
A cold and frosty morning on Wednesday, then a sunny morning for many before cloud, rain and hill snow move into the northwest. Remaining dry with sunny spells in the south. Thursday, will see cloud and rain clear the south with showers for the northwest of the UK.
