

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 1945 on Saturday 03 Jan 2009

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Patchy rain or drizzle, with hill snow, will become more widespread across Scotland through the morning then extend southwards across northern and eastern England during the afternoon and evening. Risk of icy conditions as rain falls onto frozen surfaces. Elsewhere early fog then dry and cold with some sunshine developing.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

A risk of icy conditions over southern parts early on Monday, otherwise another mostly dry and cold day with sunny periods after early frost and fog slowly clear. Outbreaks of rain and hill snow are again likely in northern areas on Tuesday, other parts dry and cold after overnight frost.
