Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A frosty start for most then generally bright in northern England, Scotland, Northern Ireland and Wales with sunny spells. Isolated showers in northeast Scotland. Southern England will be cold, windy and cloudier with scattered wintry showers. Tonight, wintry showers will become isolated with a widespread frost and some icy patches.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday, mainly dry and cold with bright or sunny spells, the best of these in western parts. Isolated wintry showers possible in the far south where the cold wind will persist. Dry and bright on Saturday and feeling less cold with much lighter winds. Wintry showers in the far north.
