Introduction

This publication contains monthly and annual averages of the total and daily duration of bright sunshine together with the highest and lowest monthly totals recorded.

All stations (195) with a homogeneous record of 20 years or more and recording sunshine at the end of 1970 have been included. Monthly values for stations with less than 30 years of record have been estimated and therefore all the values given refer to the period 1941–70.

Presentation of the averages

The averages are presented in the form of a table for each station. The station name, administrative area, and the grid reference of the site of the sunshine recorder, together with the height of the recorder (in metres) above mean sea level are given above each table. Where there has been a change of site these details refer to the site in use in 1970. Stations are listed in alphabetical order within administrative areas, these being listed roughly in north–south order within climatological districts. It should be noted that as a result of the Local Government Acts of 1972 and 1973 the boundaries and names of some of the counties in England and Wales were changed with effect from April 1974, and in Scotland new administrative regions were established with effect from May 1975. There have been consequent changes to the names and boundaries of the climatological districts. The revised counties, regions, and climatological districts are used in this volume.

Each table is divided into four columns of figures, with values for each calendar month and for the year. For each month the first and second columns give the average monthly total of bright sunshine in hours and tenths and the daily total in hours and hundredths. The third and fourth columns give the highest and lowest monthly totals, respectively, of bright sunshine recorded (or in some cases statistically estimated from a neighbouring station) during the 30-year period 1941–70. For the year, the values given are the average annual total, the average daily total and the highest and lowest annual totals recorded (or estimated). The actual period of observation used in the compilation of each table is given in the heading.

Estimation of the averages

The averages refer exclusively to the period 1941–70. Monthly values for any missing intervals, in no case exceeding 10 years in all, have been estimated using a ratio method. For example, if station A had 300.0 hours of sunshine in January over 25 years and station B, the nearest suitable comparison station, had 310.0 hours over the same period, the ratio A:B is 0.968. The monthly values of sunshine at station B, for the years when values were not available at station A, were multiplied by this ratio to produce the probable values at station A. The 30-year average was then computed in the usual way.

The observations

Each station used a Campbell–Stokes pattern sunshine recorder which consists of a glass sphere mounted concentrically with a grooved metal collar into which a

graduated card is fitted. The sphere acts as a burning glass and sunshine duration is recorded by a scorched or burnt line on the card which is changed daily. A detailed account of the instrument will be found in the Handbook of Meteorological Instruments (Meteorological Office, 1975) or the Observer's Handbook (Meteorological Office, 1969).

The averages refer to 'bright' sunshine because the Campbell–Stokes pattern recorder does not register a burn on the card below a certain minimum level of incident radiation (about 150 to 300 W/m²). On a clear day with a cloudless sky the burn does not start until 15–30 minutes after sunrise and usually ceases about the same period before sunset. The period varies with the season and the transparency of the atmosphere. The loss of burn is mainly due to atmospheric absorption and scattering of transmitted light. It is also partly due to the reduction of the effective optical aperture of the sphere by the projecting horns of the metal collar which holds the cards. The loss from this cause has been shown to be small (Meteorological Office, 1926).

On the other hand the duration recorded by the burn exceeds the real duration during periods of intermittent bright sunshine because the burn 'spreads'. Theoretically the diameter of the sun's image formed by the glass sphere is about 0.7 mm, but the width of the burnt spot made on the card by a few seconds' exposure to bright sunshine is about 2 mm. Consequently, in intermittent sunshine, the burns may be indistinguishable from those made in continuous sunshine. Observers are instructed, in the Observer's Handbook (Meteorological Office, 1969), to make allowance for the spread of the burn when measuring it, even so some exaggeration of the recorded duration cannot be avoided except during periods of uninterrupted or weak sunshine. Checks of observers' measurements are made by staff of the Meteorological Office to ensure, as far as possible, a consistent standard of sunshine card analysis.

Obstructed sites

At some stations obstacles prevent the sunshine from being recorded for some part of the day. In some cases they affect the record only in certain months; in others the record is affected throughout the year. The practice of using the letter S to show that the sunshine was obstructed for more than 5 per cent of the time when the sun's altitude was 3° or more above the horizon was introduced in the Monthly Weather Report in 1926. The same system, slightly modified, is used here. In most cases the letter S indicates that, in the month concerned, the site was obstructed for 20 years or more during the period 1941–70. S has been used in the few remaining cases to indicate a station whose history shows obstructions for less than 20 years yet whose duration of sunshine appears to be unreasonably low when compared with neighbouring stations. Further details may be obtained from the Meteorological Office. Obstructions are most likely with low elevation of the sun and, in judging their effect, it must be remembered that the average recorded duration of sunshine within an hour of sunrise and sunset is small, because of the effects of cloud, haze and atmospheric absorption, even when the horizon is unobstructed (Meteorological Office, 1937). No corrections have been applied to the averages presented here to take account of obstructions. A method of adjusting sunshine averages at an obstructed site has been developed by Furmage (1970).

Possible duration of sunshine

Table I (page vii) gives the daily mean duration of possible sunshine between latitudes 50°N and 60°N. This is defined as the interval between the ascending and descending transits of the upper limb of the sun across the horizon, allowance being made for refraction. The values have been calculated from figures given in the Smithsonian Tables using mean values of solar declination for 1971. Values for intermediate latitudes can be calculated by interpolation between adjacent columns of Table I.

The variation in possible sunshine from year to year amounts to less than 0.1 hour per day, the variations being greatest in equinoctial months and least in solstitial months. Table I may therefore be used in conjunction with the 30-year averages to compute percentages of possible sunshine. Station latitudes may be estimated from the maps (Figures 1 and 2).

Comparison with previous 30-year averages

Averages for the period 1941–70 are compared with those for earlier 30-year periods at 6 representative stations in Table II (page viii).






