Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Persistent rain across southern Scotland, northern England, Northern Ireland and parts of Wales. Showers elsewhere, perhaps heavy. The best of any brightness in northern Scotland and southeast England where showers will be fewer. Tonight, showery outbreaks of rain will extend across England and Wales, some heavy bursts. Some dry spells too, especially in Scotland and southeast England.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday, cloudy with rain or showers, perhaps heavy with a risk of hail and thunder, most likely in the east. More persistent rain in the north. Wednesday, occasionally heavy and thundery showers across England and Wales, drier in the north and southwest later.
