Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Much of Scotland will start cloudy and wet, sunny periods and occasional showers spreading from the northwest. Northern Ireland will have sunny periods and isolated, light showers. England and Wales will start dry with sunny periods, early fog patches soon clearing, although cloud will increase in the northwest, bringing patchy light rain later. Temperatures will rise to near or a little above normal for most.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:  
Cloudy with spells of rain in northern and some western parts. Otherwise it will be mostly cloudy, but mainly dry and generally warm, very warm in the southeast, where there will be some sunshine.
