Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Heavy, thundery rain or showers is expected to affect many parts through today. Eastern parts of both Scotland and England will have the best of any dry, sunny weather this morning. Further west, it will be mostly cloudy with showery rain becoming more widespread, some heavy and thundery. Thunderstorms will develop more widely across eastern England later this afternoon, local torrential downpours expected. Warm and humid, locally very warm in the brighter southeast.

Overnight, heavy downpours will clear as fresher conditions spread east. However, under clearer skies mist or fog patches are expected and showers will continue near northwestern coasts.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Fresher but still quite warm with a good deal of dry, bright or sunny weather in the south, the north rather more changeable with showers then rain.
