Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
England and Wales will be dry and mainly sunny, with light winds. Northern Ireland and much of Scotland will be cloudier and breezy, with northwestern Scotland seeing a little rain at times. Overnight, mainly dry and clear with frost, however the far northwest seeing persistent rain and brisk westerly winds.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

On Tuesday, southern Britain staying dry with some sunshine. Wet and windy in the north, with rain moving southeast and wintry showers following into the northwest. By Wednesday, the north remaining windy, with wintry showers and some snowfall; most likely on hills. Remaining drier and brighter towards the south.
