Headline:

Outbreaks of rain/sleet/snow, persistent at times, especially over E/SE.England.

This Evening and Tonight:

Snow and strong winds continuing in SE.England, widespread disruption likely. Wintry showers in northern and eastern parts. Elsewhere, clear and frosty. Widespread ice.

Thursday:

Sleet/snow and strong winds in SE.England. Rain in north later. Otherwise mostly dry, isolated wintry showers. Cold.

Outlook for Friday:

Rain/sleet and possibly snow clearing southern parts around lunchtime. Otherwise mainly dry with wintry showers, mostly around coasts. Rather cold.
