

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Friday 27 May 2016

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain will die out across Northern Ireland, southern Scotland and northern England with sunny spells developing. However, cloud will linger near North Sea coasts. Elsewhere there will be warm sunshine and scattered showers, these heavy and thundery in the southwest and Wales. Overnight, thundery showers will affect southern and western areas. Elsewhere it will clearer, with patchy low cloud.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Low cloud should retreat towards North Sea coasts to leave many parts dry with warm sunshine on Saturday. However, showers are likely in the south and west, some heavy and thundery. This mix of sunshine and showers will continue on Sunday.
