Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Heavy, persistent rain will affect Northern Ireland, Wales and southwest England this morning, gradually spreading into northern and eastern parts of England today and tonight. This will be accompanied by strong southeasterly winds, although the winds will ease in southwestern and central areas as the rain clears later. Scotland will be largely dry but very windy throughout.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

It remains windy across Scotland on Tuesday, with rain affecting many parts of the country. Winds will be lighter elsewhere with a mixture of sunny spells and sharp showers. Scattered heavy, locally thundery showers and sunny intervals will affect most parts on Wednesday.
