Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Rain or showers for most of the UK, these heavy in places, particularly England and Wales, with occasional brighter intervals in-between. Strong northwesterly winds will be the other feature of the day; thus feeling quite chilly. Northern Ireland and southwest England should start to dry-up with bright spells later in the afternoon.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Much drier and brighter for many on Friday, and less windy. Still rather cool though with a few showers in the east, and turning cloudier later towards northwest Britain. On Saturday, another band of cloud and rain will sink southeastwards, with brighter, more showery weather following behind.
