Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain spreading eastwards across the UK, with some hill snow in Scotland. Blustery showers and brighter spells following, showers heaviest in the northwest. Generally milder but staying cold in northern Scotland. Tonight, showers in the northwest while rain slowly pushes north across the south. Eastern parts mostly dry and chilly. Windy with gales tonight in the far south.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Wednesday, locally heavy rain and strong winds will spread eastwards across the south making it feel cool. Brighter in the north with scattered showers, these frequent and heavy in the northwest. Rain clearing south early Thursday leaving breezy, showery weather.
