

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Showers across northern and western Scotland gradually becoming confined to the north during the day. A few scattered showers developing across south-west England, Wales and Northern Ireland, the odd moderate one, especially during the afternoon. Elsewhere will see a dry day with variable cloud and sunny intervals.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Patchy rain across western parts on Monday, and whilst central areas will be cloudy, eastern parts should see the best of the bright spells. This rain becoming heavier and more persistent later in the day and spreading erratically eastwards overnight and through Tuesday accompanied by strong winds. Brightening up in the west later.
